



PPNC Honorary Degree Program

To honor and show appreciation to PPNC members for outstanding photographic ability, and for unselfish service to this organization, degrees will be awarded.

Photographic Fellowship; By earning credits, you may be awarded the beautiful GOLD MEDALLION.

On a red ribbon, provided 35 of these credits are earned in approved print competition; the other 15 must be earned in service and or education to the photographic profession, for a total of 50 credits.

On a black ribbon, provided 35 of these credits are earned in service to the photographic profession and the other 15 may be earned in approved print competition or education, for a total of 50 credits.

On a red and black ribbon, provided 35 of these credits are earned in approved print competition and 35 of these credits are earned in service to the profession, plus 30 additional credits which may be earned in either print competition, service and/or education to the profession (or a combination of the two), for a total of 100 credits.

Associate Fellowship; By earning 35 credits, either in approved print competition or service and/or education to the photographic profession, or a combination of the two members will receive recognition in the form of a Certificate.

Gold Chevron; After the Gold Medallion has been earned, the Gold Chevron is added to the ribbon for each 50 additional credits.
