

PPNC 2008 Auction Guidelines

1. There will be a maximum of 15 items per person. If you have more than 15 items that you would like to sell, group them in boxes as a lot. The item will bring a higher sales price if the top or outside of the box is briefly and clearly labeled with the items enclosed. It also helps if each box has items that pertain to each other rather than a grab bag of items.
2. We will not accept broken equipment, if you know it does not work, please do not represent it as working. Each member has read and signed a code of ethics and we expect for this to apply to the auction as well.
3. There will be no minimums under \$100.00. With the amount of items handled, PPNC cannot guarantee that minimums will be enforced, although we will make every effort possible. Minimums must be listed on lot tags as well as on the seller registration sheet or they WILL NOT BE VALID.
4. No individual frames will be accepted. Frames must be sold in lots of three or more.
5. Any items boxed together must be sold as a lot. A box full of individual lots may be sold as a group.
6. Rules will be read before and during the auction by the auctioneer or the chairman. The speaker will spell out the above rules as well as the 10% buyers and 10% seller's fee. This fee goes to PPNC and will be deducted from the sellers payment check and added to the buyer's purchases.
7. If you are a seller, please list all items for sale on the seller's consignment sheet. Please list each item (if individual) and each box (if grouped). Each seller will be assigned a lot letter beginning with Letter A and continuing until all sellers receive a "Lot" assignment.
8. Broken or partially working items will not be auctioned; the PPNC website can be used for these sale items.
